Jeanne M. Caruso, of Eastlake, Ohio, passed away May 4, 2020 at Lake West Hospital at the age of 72 after a long battle with many health issues, including esophageal cancer. She was born on May 11, 1947 in Cleveland, Ohio to Floyd and Dorothy Parent. Jeanne grew up in Mentor Headlands and graduated from Mentor HS in 1965. She married Robert Caruso in 1966 and they raised two sons and one daughter together in Painesville, Ohio. She also loved seeing her grandchildren, and she was very proud of their many accomplishments. She was a very caring and compassionate person who could befriend anyone and always had a smile. She touched many lives, and she will be dearly missed by many. Jeanne is survived by her son Jim Caruso; daughter Laureen (Warner) Anderson; grandchildren Brianna, Rachel, and Jared Anderson; ex-husband Robert (Robin) Caruso; brother Jim (Mary) Parent; sisters Dorothy (Ray) Marthey, Nancy (Bill) Bilger, and Katherine (Carl) Bartlett; and many nieces and nephews. She also leaves behind her dear longtime friends Liz Miller and Barbara Jeffreys, along with numerous other friends. She was preceded in death by her parents and her beloved son, David Caruso.
