



Agnes Louise Krasovec

November 3, 1924 - August 8, 2023

Agnes L. Krasovec (Hicks) (nee Moreland), passed away on August 8, 2023, living to the ripe old age of 98. She was born on November 3, 1924 in Altoona, Pennsylvania to the late Carl Moreland and Agnes Killian. The family moved to Cleveland when she was four years old. Her brother Joe was born in Cleveland. Agnes and Joe "Buddy" were raised in the Collinwood neighborhood as well as her future husband James Robert Hicks. James was born on August 26, 1923 in Cleveland to Irwin Hicks and Anna Kubinsky (Not Conwell). James and Agnes both graduated from Collinwood High School and were married November 17, 1945.
