A Funeral Service will be held on Friday, October 3, 2025, at 10:00 AM at the

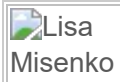
funeral home. Andrew will be laid to rest at Crown Hill Cemetery in Twinsburg, Ohio.

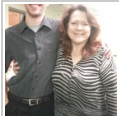
