ANNIE was a woman of many accomplishments: Parish Council President and Inaugural Parish Festival Planning Team member at St. Mary Magdalene; Eucharistic Minister and Lector at various parishes; coleader of multiple woman's faith-sharing groups; Executive Director, Board Chairwoman, and founding House Mother of Open Door Maternity Home; Administrative Assistant to executives in private, public, and charitable sectors. ANNIE was a woman in and through whom GOD ACCOMPLISHED so much.

"If it's good, it's from God" (James 1:17) was Annie's answer to anyone crediting her with God's work. Many babies were saved from abortion by God's work through her and others in the Open Door ministry. Many souls were saved by God's work through her (and Greg) in the Bible studies she helped organize for Greg to lead. During her final five years of life --- after receiving a terminal cancer diagnosis in 2019 --- hundreds of prayerful friends were led ever deeper in their faith by Annie's courageous, humble, inspiring witness. She embraced her crosses without complaint, giving honor and thanks to God for this last "Great Adventure". Annie never sought the spotlight or glory. She sought only to be God's good and faithful servant, a loving wife, friend, and family member through whom God's Light would shine for His glory. That is why Annie is so GREATLY LOVED and MISSED by so many.

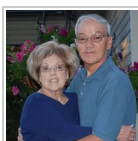
