Bill Hach, age 59, of Euclid, passed away on May 22, 2017. He was born in Euclid on February 6, 1958.

Bill was a beloved musician and entertainer in the Cleveland area for nearly 40 years of his life. He performed many solo gigs but has been with the band Rebels Without Applause since its start. The band proudly just celebrated their 35th anniversary together. Through music, Bill did a lot of charity work for the elderly and mentally handicapped and played free gigs for churches. He also taught guitar to upcoming musicians for many years. In addition, Bill was an avid golfer and sports fan, especially for Cleveland sports teams. His family also remembers him for his cooking and baking. What most know about Bill is that he never met a stranger. He was a social extrovert, having a way of getting to know anybody he talked to. Most of all, Bill loved his entire family. He was an amazing man who will be greatly missed by many.

Bill was the loving father to Kelsey Hach and Katey Hach, a loving son to Frank Hach, a loving brother to David (Sue) Hach, an uncle to John (Maggie) Hach, Kelly (Chris) Berkeley, a great-uncle to three, a nephew to Warren (Nancy) Hach.

He was preceded in death by his mother Ruth Hach, and his brother Glen Hach.

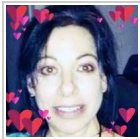

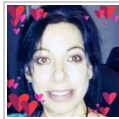
