



## Blain C. Daugherty II

May 16, 1948 - September 12, 2021

Blain C. Daugherty II, also known as "Doc", retired LIUNA International Representative and life-long resident of Northeast Ohio, died at home surrounded by family and friends on September 12, 2021 at the age of 73 after a long battle with Parkinson's disease.

Blain is survived by his wife, Gloria; his children, Deena, Joe and "Duffy"; his grandchildren: Taylor, Damon, Mason and Sydney, his great-grandson, Asher; his step-sons, Michael, Angelo and Joey; his sister, Geraldine, his brother, Douglas and numerous cousins including his cousin and close friend, Jim Daugherty.

"Doc" was born in Cleveland. In high school, he was a talented athlete, but wrestling was his focus and became a lifelong passion. He was the Assistant Wrestling Coach at Lakeland Community College and was substantially responsible for recruiting the talented individuals who together became the team to win back-to-back NJCAA National Championships in 1979 and 1980. Doc had many friends and will be deeply missed by his family and those whom he considered to be as close as family.

Visitation is scheduled for Wednesday, September 15 from 1pm-7pm followed by a service from 7 -8 pm at Monreal Funeral home in Eastlake, Ohio.
