



Bruce Kenneth Nesbett

February 25, 1948 - October 16, 2024

Bruce Kenneth Nesbett, born in Cleveland, OH on February 25, 1948, to his late parents, Norvin and Florence Nesbett (nee Sasak), passed away October 16, 2024.

He is survived by his devoted wife Joanne Nesbett (nee Zupanic); son Kenneth N. Nesbett of Chapel Hill, NC; sister Susan Kovach (Michael), and brothers-in-law Richard Zupanic (Shirley) and James Zupanic. Bruce was also loved by many nieces, nephews, and cousins. Bruce was preceded in death by his parents and brother David Nesbett.

Growing up in Euclid, Bruce graduated from Euclid High School in 1966 before bravely serving in the Marines during the Vietnam War. His courage and dedication earned him multiple honors, including the Purple Heart, Good Conduct Medal, Vietnamese Campaign Medal, and the National Defense Medal. Post-military service, Bruce worked at Hoist Equipment Company and served the community as a dedicated Laketran and Dial-A-Ride driver until his retirement in 2016.

Bruce remained active until his pulmonary fibrosis diagnosis. He found joy in swimming classes at the Willoughby YMCA, his membership in the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame, and the countless connections made during his travels. His generous spirit and infectious laughter will be deeply missed by all who had the privilege of knowing him.

Family and friends are invited to gather and honor Bruce's memory as we commemorate his life on Wednesday, October 23, 2024 from 4:00pm to

8:00pm at Monreal Srnick Funeral Home, 35400 Curtis Blvd, Eastlake, OH 44095. Urn burial for Bruce will be held privately at Ohio Western Reserve National Cemetery.
