



## Christ Kotsos

February 14, 1937 - July 20, 2017

Christ Kotsos, 80, passed away suddenly on July 20, 2017 at his home in Willoughby, Ohio. He was born in Cleveland, Ohio on February 14, 1937, the son of Christ and Katherine (nee Gruden) Kotsos.

Christ was known as an accomplished accordionist who started his own band as a teenager, making several local television appearances and playing single engagements for dances, weddings, etc. He collaborated with the late Eddie Habat to produce a album in the early 1980s labeled "From the Heart." He worked in his father's bakery as a teenager, later attending Fenn College, after which he embarked on a career as a new car salesman working for several prestigious auto dealerships in the Cleveland area.
