David A. Granchi, a devoted husband, loving father, beloved son, cherished brother, loving nephew, and respected Coach, passed away on January 27, 2024, at the age of 50, after a valiant 17-month battle with cancer. He graduated from Mentor High School in 1991, where he displayed his athleticism in baseball and football. His infectious positive attitude and warm personality made him a beloved figure in his community and beyond.
