Memorial Mass for David Wayne Palmer, 60, of Mentor, will be noon Wednesday, July 18, 2018, at St. John Vianney Church, 7575 Bellflower Road in Mentor. Mass will be officiated by Father Tom Johns. Wayne died July 11 after a short but courageous fight against lung cancer. He was born July 22, 1957, in Brownsville, Pa., to Mildred and David Palmer.
