She then worked at Eastlake Middle School as the school nurse where she built incredible relationships with all the students and her colleagues. Debi always said she loved all her jobs. Debi was a vibrant little bubble, magically always sparkling with life. She would frequently enter a room proclaiming, "Ladies! Ladies! We can do this!!!" Debi was a hugely

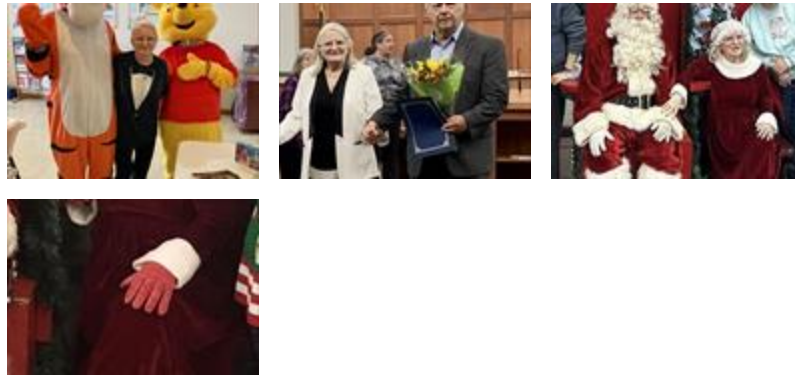
