Mr. Compola died April 15, 2000, at Hospice House in Cleveland.

Born Aug. 5, 1918, in Cleveland, he lived in Willowick before moving to Timberlake 34 years ago.

He was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II. He was a part-time Timberlake police from 1967 to 1985 and as a volunteer firefighter for Timberlake.
