Frank Joseph Dalessio was born to Samuel and Sarafina Mazza Dalessio on June 30, 1933 in Beyer, P.A. He was a graduate of Marion Center High School in Marion Center, P.A. Frank was an Army Veteran who served during the Korean Conflict. He married Shirley Fleming on June 22, 1957 and was married for 57 years. Moving to Willoughby from Cleveland in 1961 settling in Ridge Acres, he was a long-time parishioner of Immaculate Conception Church. He worked for and retired after 34 years from the General Electric Quartz Plant in Willoughby.

Frank was an avid deer hunter, fishman, softball and basketball player. He enjoyed playing pool and cornhole at the Willoughby Senior Center.
