



Jerald Anton Sustarsic

December 5, 1949 - March 18, 2025

Jerald Anton Sustarsic, known to all as Jerry, peacefully passed away on Tuesday, March 18, 2025, at the age of 75, surrounded by the love and prayers of his family and friends.

Born on December 5, 1949, to the late Honorable Tony and Helen (Palsa) Sustarsic, Jerry was a passionate and dedicated individual throughout his life. He was a proud member of the St. Joseph High School Marching Band and had the honor of performing in the 1964 St. Patrick's Day Parade in New York City. Jerry graduated from St. Joseph High School in 1968.

Jerry is survived by his loving wife of 50 years, Geraldine (Nielsen); his son, Tony (Sara Hufnagle); daughter, Paula (Woody) Wood; sister, Judy (Rick) Malachowski; grandchildren, Jordan Wood, Eddie, Alex, Joe Wood, and Little Tony; and many cherished extended family members and friends. He shared a special bond with his cousin, Dennis (Vicki) Sustarsic, with whom he spent many Friday nights.

After high school, Jerry served in the Ohio National Guard for six years, embodying his sense of duty and service. From 1972 to 2012, he worked as a draftsman at CT Consultants (formerly Frank Thomas and Associates). Jerry's deep commitment to service extended to his community as well, following in his family's footsteps by serving the residents of Euclid for nearly two decades. He held the position of Civil Service Commissioner, appointed by Mayor Tony Guinta, and spent twelve years on City Council, including as Council President. A proud moment for Jerry was serving alongside his son

on City Council from 2003 - 2005.

Jerry was also deeply involved in several organizations, including the American Legion Post 343, where he once served as Post Commander, and the Euclid Veteran's Club. He was a lifelong member of Ss. Robert and William Catholic Parish.

In his personal life, Jerry found joy in spending time with his grandchildren, exploring new restaurants, traveling, and enjoying a good Manhattan. He was a fan of big band music and the band Chicago, a die-hard Cleveland Browns supporter, and had a talent for sharing dad jokes. Above all, Jerry will be most remembered for the immense love he had for his wife, Gerry.

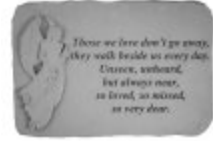
