Laurie Krieke Krych, 57, of Wickliffe, went home to our Lord and Savior May 4, 2011, after an extended illness surrounded by her loving family.

Born June 27, 1953, in Buffalo, N.Y., she had lived in Wickliffe for more than 25 years.

Laurie was a graduate of Wickliffe High School. She was a longtime member of the Wickliffe Cemetery Board, volunteering hundreds of hours of her time with her friends and fellow members to beautify the cemetery each year for memorial day. She was also a member of the Wickliffe Holiday lighting Ceremony Committee and a volunteer at the Wickliffe Senior Center craft room. Laurie was an avid gardener and artist, who had been a 28-year exhibitor at the Lake County Fair and managed the fine arts building. Laurie was also grateful for the help of her special friend A.D. She was dedicated to animal rescue, especially cats.

Laurie and her husband were the 2002 Civic Persons of the Year for Wickliffe Area Chamber of Commerce and she also helped her husband in his many campaigns. Laurie's family knew her as someone who was a loving wife, mother and friend.

Mrs. Krych worked as a floral designer at Michael's and Borlin's. She also was a cook at Spats and Chesters.

Survivors are her husband of 38 years and high school sweet heart, David; daughter, Kimberley Reno Barber; two sons, Michael Amanda and Daniel Melinda Krych; grandchildren, Joseph, Kaitlyn, Johnathan and Collin; sisters,

She was preceded in death by her father, Daniel Krieke; and mother, Joan Krieke.
