Micki had a love of musicals, especially Phantom of the Opera, concerts, the Browns, Indians, Lake Erie Monsters, and occasionally toilet papering her unsuspecting friends' yards.

Above all, Micki's grandchildren were her greatest joy. "Grama," as she liked to be called, was their biggest fan. Micki loved attending their sporting events. She would often be seen (and heard) in the bleachers with a sign or a cowbell. Micki was best known for loudly yelling "Woo hoo!" whenever her grandchildren made a good play.

Micki was preceded in death by her parents and her beloved granddaughter, Ellie Godina.
