Mary Ann Aitutis, 94 (nee Baskovic) passed away in her sleep, peacefully, on September 10, 2024. She is preceded in death by her mother Mary Baskovic (nee Perhne), Father Frank Baskovic and brother Frankie

She also had a special group of "dear friends" she made while living on Cold Creek

Trail. She enjoyed attending her grandkids sporting events, music and dance recitals and teaching them how to play poker and other card games. She would often come over on the weekends for poker tournaments or to go out for Mexican Nachos with extra-extra cheese sauce. In 2016 Mary Ann moved to Parker Place Gracious Retirement Living in Mentor, OH (again) to be closer to Joey, Patti and the kids. It was no secret Mary Ann loved most seeing her son, Joey, play music with the Riders in the Sky or at various Slovenian/Polka dances. She was extremely proud of her son and the Slovenian heritage and traditions of her father that Joey not only embraced but passed along to his children and grandchildren. She was even the first person to carry his accordion for him so he could go to lessons as a small child; a memory Joey has cherished and appreciated his entire life and career. Mary Ann loved and was loved by her family and had a beautiful life. She will be missed but her memory will live on in each of us.

A funeral mass of Christian burial will take place on October 19th at 11:00am at Divine Word Catholic Church in Kirtland, OH, with a light reception/luncheon to follow in the church hall.
