September 29, 1926 - May 19, 2023

Mee Lun Hom, beloved wife, mother, grandmother, aunt, and sister passed away on May 18th, 2023, at age 96 at the Village of the Falls Skilled Nursing Facility in Olmsted Falls, OH.

Mee Lun was born in Boston, MA on September 29th, 1926, at what was once the Boston City Hospital. She became an English and Chinese school teacher in New York City, living in both China and the US until meeting her future husband, Thomas, a returning US Army soldier, in 1946. The pair married and moved to Youngstown, OH where Thomas' family resided until moving to Euclid, OH with their two children, David and Diane. Mee Lun was a dedicated mother and housewife, later entering the catering business with her extended family and raising her children in Eastlake, OH. In 2002, she moved to Parsippany, NJ to be a doting grandmother to David's children, Emily and Jackson. In 2012, Mee Lun moved back to Ohio to care for Diane's daughter, Kristina and live independently in Willoughby Hills until 2022.

Mee Lun enjoyed watching professional American sports (baseball and football), cooking, and oddly, C-SPAN congressional debates.

She is survived by her daughter (Diane of Mentor, OH), son (David and spouse, Felicia of Wrentham, MA), three grandchildren Emily (20), Kristina (19), Jackson (18), and many nieces and nephews.

Mee Lun was preceded in death by her parents, Woo Gee Wun and Huie Shee, her husband, Thomas Lee Hom, her three brothers (David Mahr, Robert Woo, William Woo) and their wives.

Family will receive friends on Saturday, May 27, 2023, from 9am till 11am. A funeral Service will be held at 11am also at the funeral home. Mee Lun will be laid to rest at Green Haven Memorial Gardens in Canfield, OH.
