Otis was born on July 20, 1933, in Morgantown, West Virginia, to the late Vincent A. and Caterina Morony. His parents journeyed from Italy to build a life in the United States, and Otis was proudly born and raised in Morgantown, where he graduated from West Virginia University. In 1955, Otis moved to Euclid, Ohio, eventually settling in Willowick, where he remained a proud and dedicated resident for 65 years.

He was a proud Veteran of the US Army and a member of American Legion Post 678 in Willowick. He was also a member of American Legion Post 462 in Linesville, PA. and a member of the VFW Post 3863 in Eastlake. He was a member of the Willowick Jaycees and a member of the GM Retiree Club. Mr. Morony was a former employee as Supervisor of Labor Relations at the GM-Fisher Body Plant in Euclid, OH. He retired in 1987 with 32 years of service.
