Patricia Vouk, formerly of Barjode Road in Willowick and later of Willoughby passed away peacefully Sunday, December 22, 2024, at Vista Springs Quail Highlands in Concord. Patricia was born on January 24, 1936, the daughter of Laddislaus (Laddie) and Catherine (Caroline) (Burnoskey) Khas.

Patricia, well-known as Pat, leaves to forever cherish her memory her three sons, Keith (Louise) of Kirtland, Kevin (Nancy) of Concord, and Kurt (Elizabeth) of Yardley, Pa; her grandchildren, Gabrielle (Patrick Drabik), Hannah, Kevin (Alli), Victoria, Benjamin, and great-granddaughter Lainey. Additionally, she was the owner/operator of the former Hair Fashion Studio in Willowick for many years.
