



Randolph "Randy" J. Primozic

Randolph "Randy" J. Primozic Sr. of Willoughby Hills, age 82, passed away peacefully April 17, 2021 after a fight with cancer. Randy was surrounded by his loving family at Hillcrest Hospital in Mayfield.

Born March 29, 1939 to the late John and Amelia (Peskar) Primozic he is survived by his wife of 62 years Carol (nee Gruss).

He was preceded in death by daughters, Michelle, Lynette and Denise.

Randy was a graduate of Willoughby Union High School. Joined the Coast Guard after graduation and served from 1956-1960. He started a career as a service technician in the commercial HVAC industry. His training in heating and refrigeration was advanced at classes at Max Hayes Tech School.

Randy's life was one of learning, inventing, drag racing and family. With the help of his wife Carol those interests were turned into several family run businesses. Northeastern Refrigeration, his own commercial HVAC company was created and that experience lead him to think of a better way to refrigerate and display cut flowers at retail. He was awarded two patents for his innovative work in this field. Many other processes were incorporated in

his floral display fixtures that were industry firsts. As a result, Floraline Display Products became an industry leader in grocery store floral departments.

Randy also had a passion for drag racing. As a young man he would visit the local airport for high octane fuel for his race cars. Randy eventually started drag racing in the Top Sportsman Class, competing with a number of self-built "door" cars. He regularly posted 200mph , 6 second quarter mile races. He was the winner of the IHRA Iron Man Classic and the NHRA Wally Parks trophies. His motto, " Life begins at 200 mph" is displayed in his garage.

A mass will be held to honor his life on Tuesday, April 27, 10 am at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel 1730 Mount Carmel Drive, Wickliffe, OH. Burial services will immediately follow at All Souls Cemetery 10366 Chardon Rd, Chardon, OH 44024.
