Richard John Mott, born October 29, 1931, in Cleveland, OH to William and Mary (nee Komin) Mott. Brother of William, Robert, Bernice (nee Tramsak) all deceased.

Immediately upon graduating from Cathedral Latin High School, in 1950 he entered upon a branch banking career that spanned 43 years. He joined North American Bank which merged with Central National Bank, which merged with Society Bank. After its merger with Key Bank, he retired in 1993. He was an Asst. V.P. and branch manager.

He entered the U.S. Army from 1952 to 1954. He served 17 months in Korea and attained the rank of Sgt. He was awarded the Commendation Ribbon with Medal Pendant.

Richard will be laid to rest at All Souls Cemetery in Chardon.

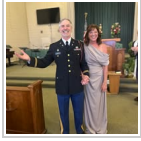

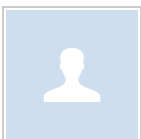
