



Robert Gerard Carney

July 12, 1945 - May 6, 2024

Robert "Bob" Carney, a devoted husband, cherished father, and loving grandfather, passed away peacefully in his home on May 6, 2024, surrounded by his family. Born on July 12, 1945, in Carmel, CA, to the late Joseph and Rita Carney. He will be forever remembered and deeply missed by his beloved wife of 56 years, Marilyn Carney (Vasil), his children Kelly Carney and Joseph (Sharon) Carney, and his adored grandchildren Franklin, Thomas, and Samuel Carney. Bob was preceded in death by his brothers Rev. Joseph Carney and Timothy (Mary) Carney.

Bob dedicated many years of his life in service to his country, serving as a Military Police Officer in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War, first in Okinawa, then in Vietnam, and ending in Ft. Knox. He received several accolades for his bravery and service, including the Bronze Star. Following his military career, Bob continued to serve his community as a Detective Sergeant in the Euclid Police Department, where he spent over 26 years, receiving many accolades including the Combat Cross. Bob made a lasting impact through his work in the Narcotics and Vice Unit, retiring as the Officer in charge.

Bob had a love for the great outdoors, particularly camping and fishing, where he found solace and joy. He was also a talented artist, with a special passion for ceramics. His sense of humor and warm demeanor endeared him to all

who knew him.
