Robert W. Srnovrsnik, beloved husband, father, son, brother, uncle, cousin, and friend, passed away unexpectedly on February 9, 2023, at the age of 53. He was born on April 6, 1969, in Euclid, OH.

Bob, also known to many as Rob, graduated from Euclid High School in 1987, where he was active in the HS Band. He was proudly employed, and dedicated 22 years to Prisco-Quantum Coatings.
