Scott Hardwick, known to friends as "Hardy," and "Papa" to his family, passed away peacefully at home on September 27 at the age of 56.

Scott Stuart was born on September 17, 1962 to George and Myrtle Hardwick (nee Fox). A proud Wickliffe native, he graduated from Wickliffe High School in 1980, and Cleveland State University in 1985. He worked at Rockwell Automation, formerly known as Reliance Electric, for 32 years and last held the title of Manager Strategic Sourcing & Supplier Diversity.

As "The Ambassador of Strategic Sourcing and Inclusion," Scott was vital to the success of Rockwell's Supplier Diversity Program. Winning many awards, he traveled the world in that capacity - having visited China, Germany, and all across the US - making friends wherever he went.

He is survived by his wife of 22 years, Cynthia (nee McKean), daughter Shannon Smith (Brandon) and five grandchildren – Halle, Brynne, Grayson, Rowan and Braden. He also leaves loving brothers James (Debra) and

Gregory (Karen), seven nieces and nephews, nine great nieces and nephews, and many cherished friends. He is preceded in death by his parents, George and Myrtle.
