



## Stephen A. Turoczy

August 22, 1933 - April 3, 2005

Stephen A. Turoczy passed away Sunday, April 3, at Lake West Hospital in Willoughby. Mr. Turoczy is survived by his wife of 47 years, Mary Ann Bohutinsky, three children and eight grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, Stephen J. and Anna R. Turoczy, and a great-grandson, Dylan Walsh.

Stephen served in the U.S. Air Force as a Senior Airman during the Korean War. He was a member of the occupation forces of Germany and the first American to be attached to the Dutch Air Force Weather Service. He was a member of the American Legion Post #678, the Eastlake VFW, and the Parish Council at St. Justin Martyr Church. He was a Councilman for the Village of Lakeline; and he retired from Cres-Cor in Mentor in 1999.
