



## Thomas M. Bunch

February 14, 1935 - January 25, 2021

Thomas M. Bunch, age 85, of Anderson, IN formerly of Eastlake, OH, passed away peacefully on January 25, 2021, after a courageous battle with multiple myeloma. He was born in Cleveland, on February 14, 1935, to the late Lucien McReynolds Bunch and Jessie Dulzer Bunch.

He was a proud and loving husband, father, and grandfather, who will be greatly missed by all who knew him. Thomas is survived by his wife Candance Bunch, children Ann Marie Bunch, Joseph Bunch and Karen (Ray) Hoon, grandchildren Austin Hoon, Nicolette Hoon, Raymond Hoon, and Autumn Hoon.
