Thomas Edwin Stevenson, 75, died Nov. 18, 2010 following a courageous battle against aspiration pneumonia, after surviving a 6 year battle with stage 4 Lung Cancer.

He was born on August 29, 1935 in Lyndhurst, Ohio the son of Everett and Zila McGurer Stevenson.

He was a 1953 graduate of Euclid High School. He received a Bachelor's Degree from Hiram College and a Bachelor's degree in Engineering from Case University.

On Sept. 10, 1960, he married Judith Ellen Gano, his wife of 50 years.

He was a veteran of the U.S. National Guard. He worked as an engineer for Bailey Controls for 35 years until his retirement in 1996. He patented several items in his years with the company.

He was an active and dedicated member of Kirtland Christian Fellowship Church, the American Society of Mechanical Engineers, the NRA, and many Christian affiliations.

He enjoyed cars, the outdoors, all things mechanical, birds, gardening,

motorcycles, classic car shows, collecting guns, traveling and bike riding.

He is survived by his wife Judith; his children: Cindy Stevenson, Bruce Stevenson, and Sunita Justin Lee; his granddaughter Gabrielle Elisabeth Lee; his mother-in-law Eleanore Gano; his sister Irene Erwin Sladewski and sister-in-law Maxine Stevenson.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his brothers Clark and John and sisters Betty Basta and Sarah Stevenson.
